Berger, Hans

1. A check of WDA 0-2 files revealed the following: 0-2 file card refers to the arrest of a Hans Berger at Coburg, in June 1945 by 1st AIC, but there is no reference to interrogation and release or other disposition. This BERGER was born 5 October 1911, was a ... in ... at ...
The VI, Bis Brigade, and before April 1941 in employ of the Deutsche Fremdenverkehrsvereine at Salzburg. He was a Sudeten German, about 30 years old, married, had two children.

2. 0-2 files, 1 uc/SMIT/23, Interrogation of German ...
MICHUR, 0-15 Aug 45, source stated that Ustasi Hans KAMMER had been in Geneva VI/E of the NSR at Vienna since Oct. 1944. KAMMER was previously deputy leader of the VI, Bis Brigade, and before April 1941 in employ of the Deutsche Fremdenverkehrsvereine at Salzburg. He was a Sudeten German, about 30 years old, married, had two children.

3. 0-2 files, 23 official list containing a Hans BUDER, born 5 October 1911 in Althausen/Gud. This BUDER (serial no. 301730) obtained the rank of Ustasi on 7 November 1942.

4. 0-2 file card (on document) may refer to the same document, FR 65, mentioned in WDA 3519. This card lists a Major Heinz HERRMANN who was with AIC Salzburg, Air VI Hammer Unit, Innsbruck, and was arrested by English 13 Regt on 10 April 1945. A date on the card, presumably BERGER's birthdate, is 29 March 1900.

5. A check of EMB and Salzburg AIC files revealed no traces.
6. A check of ... Salzburg OIC files, and USR 0-2 files on Franz ... revealed no traces.
