Transmitted herewith are Annexes II and III of the report on []'s mission to Riga, 21-28 September 1958, supplementing Annex I forwarded with reference.</p> <p>2. It is our opinion that [] has furnished us with several good operational leads in Riga, as Headquarters will note in collating Annexes I and II. KALNINS and VESMANIS seem especially interesting. Moreover, we assume that Headquarters will endeavor to contact Alfred BRESLAW, security permitting, as it seems likely that he may have a good deal of photographic material taken in Riga and other parts of the Soviet Union and Bulgaria, which could be of operational and positive intelligence interest. If BRESLAW is contacted and debriefed, the Station would be interested in learning of any worthwhile information he gives pertaining to [] activities in Riga.</p> <p>3. The positive intelligence by-product of []'s mission is being forwarded via separate dispatch in accordance with instructions in Book Dispatch No. 777, 9 August 1958.</p>

- (a) Harold BERGMANIS (Subject spelled out his name for Source so that he would be able to properly convey the name to a friend of Subject in Stockholm.)
- (b) Date of Birth: Circa 1923
~~Place of Birth: Unknown, but presumably Latvia.~~
 Ethnic Origin: Latvian
- (c) Δ Address: Riga, Latvia
- Not obtained. Owing to the short duration of the meeting, Source was not able to get it, and Subject did not offer it; however, he lives in Riga, Latvia.
- (d) Telephone: Not obtained for same reasons as item (c).
- (e) Photo: Not obtained for same reasons as item (c).
- (f) Handwriting Sample: Not obtained for same reasons as item (c).
- (g) Physcial Description: ^{provided} About 180 cm tall; athletic looking, like a sprinter. Youthful appearance.
- (h) Occupation: Medical doctor in Riga.
- (i) Languages: Latvian. Demonstrated a good speaking ability of German. Owing to the limited time available Source was notable to test him on other languages.
- (j) Family and friends: Married. His young wife was present when Source met him, but he does not remember her name. They seemed, to Source, a loving and devoted couple.
- (k) Links: As is described on page 18, Annex I, OSSA-8085, 9 December 1958, Subject asked Source to carry a message for him to an old friend in Stockholm, a Latvian refugee by the name of Janis LUKINS, who is the Subject of OSSA-5318, 16 November 1956. Gave Source LUKINS phone number 87 33 63.
- (l) Others: Subject was well dressed for a Latvian, intelligent appearing, and had nice manners. Seemed pleasant and friendly.
- (m) Agent Relationship with Target: Source's sole five minute contact with Subject is related on page 18, Annex i, OSSA-8087. p19
- (n) Agent's Assessment of Target: Too brief a contact to say, other than the man made an initial favorable impression. By virtue of the fact that Subject wanted Source to contact a refugee friend in Stockholm, Source presumes that Subject is anti-Soviet. 67-6-2273
