- ·(c) A Address: Rigo, Latvia

Not obtained. Owing to the short duration of the meeting, Source was not able to get it, and Subject did not offer it; however, he lives in Riga, Latvia.

- (d) Telephone: Not obtained for same reasons as item (c).
- (e) Photo: Not obtained for same reasons as item (c).
- (f) Handwriting Sample: Not obtained for same reasons as item (c).
- (g) Physial Description: About 180 cm tall; athletic looking, like a sprinter. Youthful appearance.
- (h) Occupation: Medical doctor in Riga.
- (i) Languages: Latyian. Demonstrated a good speaking ability of German. Owing to the limited time available Source was notable to test him on other languages.
- (j) Family and friends: Married. His young wife was present when Source met him, but he does not remember her name. They seemed, to Source, a loving and devoted couple.
- (k) Links: As is described on page 18, Annex I, OSSA-8085, 9 December 1958, Subject asked Source to carry a message for him to an old friend in Stockholm, a Latvian refugee by the name of Janis LUKINS, who is the Subject of OSSA-5318, 16 November 1956. Gave Source LUKINS phone number 87 33 63.
- (1) Others: Subject was well dressed for a Latvian, intelligent appearing, and had nice manners. Seemed pleasant and friendly.
- (m) Agent Relationship with Target: Source's sole five minute contact with Subject is related on page 18, Annex i, OSSA-8087.
- (n) Agent's Assessment of Target: Too brief a contact to say, other than the man made an initial favorable impression. By virtue of the fact that Subject wanted Source to contact a refuge friend in Stockholm, Source presumes that Subject is anti-Soviet.
