Although Hitler was willing to send supplies as a political fauto, Goering insisted that they be paid for in spanish products. In order to accomplish this exchange, subject set up two companies, ROWAK in Berlin and HISMA in Tetuan. As the exportable surplus available to Spein consisted of products such as wines, resine, skins, cork and minerals, subject found it necessart to launch subsidiary companies to deal with each of these commodities. He therefore founded AGRO, EXPORTADORA DE PIELES, CL. GENERAL LE LENAS, HERMANN CAERTMER and LIMERALES us ESPANA, all under the control of HISMA. In the course of time other companies were either bought or acquired. Subject sep up a number of mining companies, and SOFINDUS in in possession of one of the most comprehensive mineralogical surveys ever made in Spain. HISEE became the largest and probably the most important single factors in the economy of Mationalist Spain. In 11/38 it was replaced by SOFINDUS, an organization virtually controlled by the German Government under the direction of subject. As a condition to his cooperation with the Allies, s bject has stipulated that, as he is personally indebted to many persons in Spain in high places, no trouble he coused these persons. Subject reiterated that under no circumstances would be compromise the poeple who had assisted him in his work. A British expert in Madrid considers that, although a defected enemy national, subject is still a forceful personality and a potent factor in Spanish politics. He is said to be responsible for Spain's present government, more than any other individual. Has more influence with Franco than the British and American Embassies combined. It is doubtful that the Spaniards would ever agree to hand subject over to the Allies.

A Mr. SCHEEL, formerly an employee of SCFINDUS, mentioned to a member of RX 1218 the British Trusteeship at the former German Embassy, the existence of a "secret fund" of several millions, and of a camouflaged enterprise called "An or". The fund of several millions is probably the monies handled personally by subject but there is no trace of "Anton", other than the Christian name of WAHLE. SOFINDUS was the Sp. continuation of the firm HISMA founded by subject and IX 12391 CARRANZA in Training Tetuan as cover for the support given by Goering to Franco 8/14/46 during the Civil War. SIUMROSS states that the Condor Legion later became the Interriofficial organ and tookthe place of HISMA, which then became a purely formercial SIMMROSS firm under the direction of subject and with German approval and the support of Franco; for the purpose of implementing the GORING 4 years plan as regards ROWAK, Berlin. Subject, chief of Sofindus, was former chief clerk with H & O WILMER & Co.

A report by the American Military Attache at Madrid: "Who's Who AND Actache Walther BECKER, former Commercial Attache to the German Embassy, Madrid, Spain, No. 407-45 of October 15, 1945, setting forth 2/21/46 BECKER's own account of his life and career, together with interesting info on his activities in Brazil. BECKER and subject are regarded by Madrid Embassy as the two Germans who were probably most conversant with the economic activities of the Nazi Party and Reich in Spain.

Major Fernando SANTAMARIA, Head of Falange network "D", which concerns itself with foreigners in Spain, claims that there are two classifications of Germans in Spain. One is that of Germans who continue to be Nazis, and the other of those who "have sold out to the Americans." He identifies as the outstanding member of the second group, BERNHARDT, "who has close connections of a financial and economic hature with the Allied Control Commission." He claims that BERNHARDT was mainly responsible for the fact that commercial representatives of the Bonn Government went back to Germany empty-handed after having come to Madrid to negotiate a trade arrangement with Spain. The Bonn representatives were disgisted to find that in order to carry out their negotiations, they had to deal with Nazis. SANTAMARIA thinks, however, that the main underlying reason for the failure of the negotiations is the fact that the United States controls the German economy, and does not wish to lose its hegemony.
