b. Propaganda

(1) Black propaganda broadcasts over Radio Gorianin and the QKSTAIR mailing campaign continued. In accordance with instructions issued in August, Radio Gorianin programs have begun avoiding explicit claims that broadcasts originate within Bulgaria. However, the programs are so worded that credulous listeners can readily believe that the situation is inside the country. Program content has been continually improved to bolster the impression that Radio Gorianin enjoys close contacts with developments inside Bulgaria.

- (2) Leaflets fell in the Tutrakan area in the northeast section of the country in March, 1951 according to a report of interrogation of a refugee from that area. It had been feared that the March QKSTAIR leaflet drop may have been made over Yugoslavia by mistake, but the report tends to confirm that the airdrop was made along the scheduled route.
- (3) Fifteen thousand packages containing needles and razor blades and labeled as gifts from the Freedom Brotherhood were shipped to Athens on 18 September 1951 for dropping over Bulgaria in future operational flights.

c. Infiltration

- (1) Six infiltration agents were tried in Sofia during September. Three were sentenced to death and three tolong-term imprisonment. Apparently the men were caught as a result of: (a) information furnished the militia by a defector, (b) faulty operational judgment on the part of some of the agents, and, (c) militia ambushes. It is felt that the trial has not caused serious damage to future CKSTAIR operations, because the information available to the Bulgarian authorities from the defendents must have been known to them already through agents who had defected or been captured.
- (2) Five trained W/T operators are now available in Greece for future operations. Two trained W/T operators have been retained in Germany for integration with teams now undergoing training at Grafenwohr.
- (3) The re-infiltration of the team which operated in the Haskova Area in July has been postponed because of reports of unusual preparations against the team by the Bulgarian Militia in the Haskova area.

d. Political

- (1) Ivan Kiosseivanow, another member of the proposed new Executive Committee of the BNC, has arrived in Canada on his way to the U.S.
- (2) The preparation of plans for the exploitation for OPC purposes of the broadened Bulgarian National Committee has been begun.

e. Evaluation and Comment

The major outstanding problems in OKSTAIR operations at present are:

- (a) The recruitment of agent personnel.
- (b) The assignment of Bulgarian-speaking staff personnel to the field. It is expected that the former will be at least partially solved in November with the establishment of the Guard Company. The latter problem is being met by extensive recruitment efforts and intensive language training for personnel scheduled to gotto the field.
