AUTH: ER 70.2 DATE: 6/9/25 REVIEWER a. Balgarian Geard Company - As a result of a BUCCH order, the screatth of the Bulgarian Guard Company was reduced to T/O, a reduction of 33. The discharged men will continue to reside in Germany. A total of forty Bulgarian D.Ps. entered Germany during this period with the reported intention of joining the Company. This group whose movement was never authorized by U. S. officials, was taken into sustody by the German Hilitary of the Interior. Their whereabouts, identities, and ultimate disposition is not yet known. It is possible that Toenko Barev, Georgi M. Dimitrev's European deputy, ordered these men to move to Germany in an effort to pressure the Americans into accepting more Bulgarian dependants and to bolster the prestige of Dimitrov's emigre organisation, Athens has recruited two men who will be entered in the Guard Company as American informers in hopes that by this means we can learn details of the Company's internal cross currents. To date we have only been ale to guage these currents when they emerged in the form of overt problems.
