11. Summary					
<p>The general aims of PP activities against Bulgaria embrace the establishment of clandestine nets within the country and the conduct of psychological warfare against the Bulgarian Government.</p> <p>Radio Gorianin remained on the air during the month with a daily average of 28 repeat broadcasts of a 15-minute program. Proofs of a leaflet, bearing resistance slogans, have been sent to Athens for final approval; it is planned that 200,000 of these leaflets will be infiltrated or airdropped into Bulgaria this spring. Meanwhile, plans for the reorganization of the Radio Gorianin staff have progressed; three qualified Bulgarians resident in the United States have been interviewed and are awaiting clearances.</p> <p>Negotiations continued with Dr. G. M. Dimitrov for the proposed joint operation to be launched this spring for the purpose of testing Dimitrov's assets within Bulgaria. Dimitrov submitted the names of three potential contacts within Bulgaria with whom the agent team to be infiltrated may establish contacts.</p> <p>The Chief of SE/2 (Bulgaria) will meet Ivan Mihailov, leader of the IMRO, in Rome about mid-March; discussions will center around the latter's desire to discuss the possibilities of using his organization operationally.</p> <p>CIA and USAREUR have reached an agreement whereby the Bulgarian Guard Company, now under exclusive Army control, will be kept intact pending more definite information on the proposed "Freedom Corps."</p>
