11. Summary - Mission and Plan: Project BGCONVOY, approved 6 August 1954, is an administrative device to provide for those developmental activities which have not reached an operational status sufficient to warrant individual project status, and to provide for administrative overhead and support costs not directly chargeable to station or headquarters expense.

Monthly status reports on BGCONVOY will follow the numbers of the subproposals in paragraph 5 of the Project Outline dated 28 June 1954, as follows:

(1) At the present time two covert associates, one translator, and one consultant are employed by BGCONVOY. With the exception of one covert associate on monthly salary, no use has been made of the others during the month.

(2) The processing of the two indigenous agents under Sec. 8 of the CIA Act of 1948 has not been implemented since security requirements for admission have not yet been completed.

(3) Preliminary contact with the emigre leader has been made, and arrangements have been laid on for further contact when the emigre has completed the preparation of certain information requested by the case officer. In the meantime, the payment of [ ] to assist in the publication of an issue of his newspaper on the anniversary date of "liberation" of Bulgaria by the USSR (9 September) has been approved by CPP and the funds have been transmitted with the assistance of the Cover Branch of SSD. We have received a copy of this paper.
