SOURCE

1. Ignacy Zlotowski, now Polish representative on the United Nations Atomic Energy Commission, (specialized in mathematics and physics while in school.) He is believed to have worked with the Curies (Frederick Joliot-Curie and his wife Irene) in Paris for approximately ten years (the time is uncertain but seems to have extended into the middle 1930's). In 1936-1937 he was assistant to Professor Wojciech Swietoslowski, who was then Minister of Education in Poland. (Note: according to an item appearing in one of the Polish-American newspapers, Swietoslowski, who lectured during the war in various U.S. universities, has returned to Poland and now heads the chemistry-physics division of the University of Warsaw.) (In 1937 he returned to France, where he became a member of the College de France in Paris. In 1939 he was back in Poland lecturing at a Polish university. At that time he was a staunch supporter of the Pilsudski regime and, although a Jew himself, lent his support to the anti-Jewish laws at the universities.)
2. Zlotowski came to the United States in 1939 or 1940. He took out first citizenship papers sometime in the next few years, and also sometime during this period taught at the University of Ohio. (He became quite active in Polish circles of leftish tendencies but never was a regular member of either the emigre Socialist group or the Peasant group. In 1943 he became associated with Oscar Lange, who at that time was involved in the trip to the Soviet Union with Father Orlemanski. In 1944, after the Yalta Conference, Zlotowski was among those Poles who went over to the Lublin Government. He is at present anti-Pilsudski and pro-Jewish.)
