The division of Germany into two nuministrative zones has enabled Himmler to seize some administrative posts which he has confided to SS chiefs. Until now there posts were controlled by the Martin Bormann, Chief of the Reich Chancellery.

Thus the northern part of the acich as longer is in the control of Bormann but of 30 Hellmuth Friedrich, one of Rimmler's adjutants. The administrative center of this part of the Reich is at Flersburg (Schleswig-Holstein). The naministration of the southern part of the country is at Ffullach, in Elveria, under the direction of Tormann. It Munich, however, civil affairs have seen confided to the direction of the 15 chiefs vogler and von Eberstein, who replace the Gauleiter Giesler and the mayor of the city, Fiehler.
