Subject: Martin BORMANN.

1. The following is a further contribution to the Martin BORMANN legend.

2. BORMANN is reliably reported to have been seen at Tortona, Italian Province of Alessandria, on January 10, 1945, wearing the uniform of an inspector of the German civilian railway workers.

3. As this civilian branch of the railroad personnel was always considered anti-Nazi, we are advised that most of its members have now been re-engaged. Our source feels that their ranks should be carefully combed for traces of Martin BORMANN.
