SPECIFIC—~~30~~ June Meeting with CABATON 19

1. Purpose of Meeting: The purpose of this meeting was to determine whether Subject has been able to elicit critical biographic data on his landlady and to give him a Frankfurt accommodation address.

2. Meeting Arrangements: By previous agreement the meeting took place in Lübeck on Sunday 30 June at 1300 by the old city gate directly before the Bahnhof. No surveillance was noted.

3. Meeting:

A. Case officer and subject met at the appointed time and proceeded to the Lübeck Rathaus for lunch.

B. Subject submitted DOB and POB on his landlady and said she was an inveterate CDU'er which he felt established her political reliability. Case officer said no final decision had been made on the use of subject's address for a clandestine accommodation. Subject, on questioning, said he would be able to open a postlagerkarte in any case. CO then pointed out that prior to the next meeting there could possibly be an emergency requirement to utilize his address for post from East Germany. In that case, case officer stated he would write subject a letter which would include the sentence, "I have finally bought my car" which would be signal to subject that mail would come through. The letter would be addressed with the middle initial F. instead of Subject's true middle initial J. Subject was given CABATON 5's address as a relay, being instructed to place the letter in another envelope and forward it to CABATON 5's address without breaking the seal.

C. At the previous meeting subject had talked about his interest in tennis and the difficulty of getting good balls. Consequently, CO presented subject with a can of balls at the meeting for which he was profuse in his thanks. Subject then said he was upset because his mother had been refused a visa to visit him by the East German authorities on the grounds that he, subject, had fled to the West illegally and she would not be able to get a visa for two years. Subject said he felt compelled to go see her during his vacation in October but that he was very strapped for funds and asked if there were some way we could help him. CO, having intended giving subject a DM 100 retainer, asked whether the return ticket by plane would cost in excess of DM 100. Subject said the ticket would be DM 70. CO gave him DM 100 suggesting he use the difference for any extra expenses.
