SUBJECT: Operational/Procurement of Letter Drops

ACTION REQUIRED: For your information.

1. Forwarded under separate cover are 5 names and addresses to be used as unilateral medium to high security letter drops. These 5, in addition to the 14 low level bilateral addresses previously sent under Reference C, have been furnished in response to your request as stated in EGSA-5111.

2. For each name, a brief biographic sketch has been furnished which includes a few of the individual's interests. An address has been supplied in the last paragraph of each individual's summary to which all correspondence should be directed. The addressor should use the exact name and address as given in the last paragraph of each individual's sketch but using the German words for "Tr." and "street" and for place names, etc. Please see paragraph 7, of EKAA-119, dated 28 April 1959 for examples relative to this instruction.

3. A list of 277 business firms for use in corresponding with the subject of attachment B is transmitted under separate cover.

4. It is to be noted that OAs have been granted for the subjects of S/C attachments A, B, and E. The Subject of S/C attachment C was granted a POA on 9 April 1959. An OA has never been requested for the Subject of attachment D though she has been used as a KUBARK contact by [redacted] for approximately the last six months.

5. Subject of Attachment A is a KUBARK contact and observer who thinks she works for the U.S. Army intelligence. She supplies information on Near Eastern and North African personalities and also has contacts with local Soviets. She receives no salary but is given occasional gifts and operational expenses. She is in contact with only one KUBARK case officer.
