- 3. A list of 277 business firms for use in corresponding with the subject of attachment B is transmitted under separate cover.
- 4. It is to be noted that CAs have been granted for the subjects of S/C attachments A, B, and E. The Subject of S/C attachment C was granted a POA on 9 April 1959. An OA has never been requested for the Subject of attachment D though she has been used as a KULTARK contact by for approximately the last sim months.
- 5. Subject of Attachment A is a KBBLKK contact and observer who thinks she works for the U.S. Army intelligence. She supplies information on Hear Eastern and Horth African personalities and also has contacts with local Soviets. She receives no salary but is given occasional gifts and operational expenses. She is in contact with only one KUBURK case officer.
