1. Since there is some doubt as to what happened to the test letter sent by HEROUND to CABATON 21, we have decided to issue HEROUND a different address. We will mail several more test letters from East Berlin to this address in the near future to help clarify the current security status of this address. The "absender" on these letters will be "K. HERRMANN." Please return the letters to BOB, unopened, and note the dates the letters were received by CABATON 21 and by the FOB case officer.

2. The CABATON 25 address was never actually given to CACODLES. Since CABATON 25 will be leaving Germany within a few months we do not plan to assign this address to any agent.

3. We regret not having sent the necessary test letters to CABATON 26. We will send three test letters, one per week, beginning on 7 December 1959. The "absender" on these letters will be "R. SCHULZE." The arrangements outlined in reference C for the recovery of these letters from CABATON 26 are satisfactory. We would appreciate your picking up the three envelopes as soon as possible after the receipt of the third letter, since these envelopes will have been provided with tamper indicators and will be the only means determining whether or not the letter was surreptitiously opened.
