<p>1. CABATON 38 visited Identity 1 on 26 November 1959, ostensibly to pay a personal visit. CABATON 38's wife was present to lend credence to the personal nature of the call. During the course of the visit CABATON 38 mentioned that he feared he might have some difficulty getting mail from some of his close friends and relatives still residing in the DDR. He attributed this fear to the fact that he, because of his function at the Uelsen camp, is heavily involved in processing refugees from the DDR. He wondered, therefore, if his good friend, Identity 1, would be willing to receive mail for him. Identity 1 agreed to the request in principle, but stated that because he still had close relatives in the DDR he did not wish to have too much mail coming to his own address. As a substitute, he suggested that CABATON 38 use Identity 1's father-in-law instead, Identity 2, with whom CABATON 38 is also acquainted. CABATON 38 and Identity 1 then called on Identity 2 who readily agreed to receive mail from CABATON 38's "relatives" in the DDR.</p> <p><i>MUELLER, Heinz</i> <i>arr. Germany in Halle/Saale</i> <i>POB: 5 Sept 1914</i></p> <p>2. Identity 1 is a long-time friend of CABATON 38, both coming from the same home town of Halle/Saale. Identity 1 joined the LDP in 1945 and was for some time a member of the LDP executive committee in Halle and a member of the town council. Because of his critical attitude toward the SED he was forced to withdraw from public activity and retired to his father's wholesale potato business as a junior partner. In 1955 he felt compelled to leave the DDR because his critical attitude became too widely known. At the beginning of 1956 he settled in Bielefeld and opened up a wholesale potato and garden supply business. Sometime after his arrival in Bielefeld he married Identity 2's daughter. <i>close friend of Gerhard Maymann</i></p> <p><i>JIMKAMP, Ludwig</i></p> <p>3. Identity 2 is known to CABATON 38 through the latter's association with Identity 1. Although Identity 2 is somewhat elderly, he is believed to be in good health and fully capable of handling the mail problem. He is a pensioned minor city official and considered by CABATON 38 to be fully reliable. He is a widower and has lived at his present address for many years. Mail coming to him from CABATON 38's "relatives" will bear a special indicator which will alert Identity 2 to the fact that this is mail for CABATON 38. He will then place the letter in an envelope addressed to CABATON 38 who in turn will forward it to an FOB post box.</p> <p>4. In view of the fact that Identity 1 will not be involved in the letter drop function we have not considered it necessary to do more than request traces. A trace was initially requested per EGFA-27957, 23 September 1959, but due to lack of exact date of birth it was difficult to run a satisfactory trace on a person with such a common name. Therefore, a new trace was requested per reference A.</p> <p>5. We trust that the foregoing background information will be helpful in the further processing of reference A POA request for use of Identity 2. We wish to point out, as stated in reference B, that both Identity 1</p>
