A support agent of Frankfurt Base, CABATON 32, has related information concerning</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Hans *TERNBERG Born ca 1895 Permanent address: Bodelen-Fango Gryt Sweden</p> <p>which may be of possible interest. The information is summarized in the following paragraph.</p> <p>2. Subject is at present residing in Worms, Beethovenstrasse 8, bei Kraft. Frau Kraft, a widow (employer of CABATON 32), operates a small but apparently prospering furniture and arts shop in Worms. She deals in antiques, porcelain, home furnishings, etc. Subject is allegedly a retired major from the Swedish army and has been in Worms for some time now. He seems to have plenty of money, spends a lot of time sitting in cafes, and carries on a lively correspondence with other parts of the world. He travels a great deal and often he and Frau Kraft take trips together. They both spend a lot of time in Kraft's apartment, even during the day, and CABATON 32 has on occasion been asked to send to the apartment packages which have been delivered to the store. Normally CABATON 32 is privy to all aspects of the business but the nature of the Ternberg/Kraft activity is carefully guarded from outsiders. For example, Subject and Kraft recently went on an overnight trip, saying they were going to Frankfurt. Kraft subsequently let it slip out that they had actually gone to Giessen, about 60 kilometers north of Frankfurt, thus indicating an effort to cover their travel destinations as well. Subject's behavior has also aroused the suspicion of a few other locals, such as the postman, the charwoman, and a repairman who does work in the shop. Worms, of course, is a relatively small place and anything out of the ordinary is quickly noticed. CABATON 32 showed her case officer two letters which Subject had asked her to post for him, along with the business mail. The following addresses were noted, allowing for some difficulty in reading the handwriting:</p> <p>(a) Konsumarin Lennart Glenne Grafiska Skolau Kasan 2 Skeppsholman Stockholm</p> <p>(b) Major Axel Frieberg Simborn Palm Sweden.</p> <p>3. It would appear that Subject and Kraft are involved in some kind of illicit activity. Our guess, however, is that it is more likely some kind of smuggling or customs evasion scheme rather than espionage, as CABATON 32 suspects. Nevertheless, we are forwarding the information for your interest and such action, if any, you may wish to take. Please bear in mind that CABATON 32 is an active agent of FOB and we wish to protect her identity and connection with KUBARK.</p> | | | |
