We note in your program of testing newly assigned letter drops and keeping a subsequent flow of mail going through these drops that you are posting test letters from West Berlin. While this presents no problem with respect to witting letter drops, it may arouse some curiosity on the part of the unwitting drops. Specifically, CABATONs 41, 42 and 43 are under the impression that they are receiving personal mail for CABATON 38 from the letter's friends in the DEU. We can foresee CABATON 38 being queried on this point by CABATONs 41, 42 and 43 if they continue to receive letters posted from West Berlin. In order to maintain the cover arrangement between CABATON 38 (who is witting) and the above unwitting drops, we suggest you post test letters to them from East Berlin to the maximum extent feasible.
