<p>1. We very much appreciate the information provided in reference and will make every effort to satisfy your requirements and to provide rapid transmission of operational letters.</p> <p>2. There is one major procedural point on which we differ. In the past we have followed the practice of forwarding operational letters routinely via Non-Accountable Pouch Manifest and using the dispatch form in those cases where some comment of operational significance was required. In reference you ask us to send all letters by dispatch. We are now approaching a figure of close to forty active LLDs, at least fifteen of which are assigned to BOB, and the transmittal of letters by dispatch does create additional paper work which we do not feel is essential. Furthermore, because of administrative and pouching procedures, transmittal by dispatch may delay the forwarding of a letter as much as two days. Finally, with the introduction of the new "Transmittal Manifest (CSN-F No. 43-5) form which will bear a number and which will be logged by the Base Registry, the problem of keeping an adequate record of the transmittal will be solved.</p> <p>3. As soon as an adequate supply of the new Transmittal Manifests is available we will forward operational letters routinely by TM. Please advise if you will still want three copies of the TM for BOB records.</p>
