SUBJECT Operational/CASARY/CARATON/DIEZAG/DIVEX Possibility of Using Former DIVEX-1 in CARATON Project

ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES

1. Under Separate cover attachment we are forwarding former DIVEX-1's current address which was obtained by [redacted] from [redacted] a former contract employee.

2. A review of DIVEX-1's file reveals that DIVEX-1 was a staff agent in a number of DIEZAG projects since 1 May 1950. He was known as DISCLOSE-4, DIVEX-16, DIEZ-10b, and DIEZ-6. His duties were those of a draftsman and cartographer. From April 1957 until his termination in April 1958, DIVEX-1 was used as an accommodation address for DIEZAL and DIEZET under the DIEZO Project.

3. As late as April 1959, [redacted] a KUBARK double agent (currently believed to be out-of-favor with the CIA) had upon specific requirements from the CIA, reported on the activities of DIVEX-1. It is Headquarters DIEZAG desk's opinion, however, that DIVEX-1, who fled Czechoslovakia in November 1949, cannot be considered any more, or any less, compromised to Eastern Intelligence Services than any other DIEZAG agent who defected after the Czech coup (Spring 1948).

4. We realize that both [redacted] and [redacted] know DIVEX-1 and we are wondering if it might not be helpful to first have discreetly query DIVEX-1 as to whether or not DIVEX-1 is in correspondence with anyone in Czechoslovakia. We do not mean to imply that you may not have already thought of this when you submitted your request for re-contacting
