1. Reference forwarded to FOB the status of BOB's use of the CABATON addresses. However, since reference was written we have again reviewed our accommodation addresses. Listed below are all FOB accommodation addresses which are reflected in our records (since the Spring of 1959) as having been assigned to BOB, the agents to which these addresses have been assigned, and the current status of these addresses, i.e., active, pending, or terminated/cancelled.

a. The ALBRECHT Address. This address, serviced by AENEON-16, was furnished to BOB per EGFA-25161, 6 February 1959. This address has never been assigned to a BOB operation although we have kept it on our records as available for assignment to BOB agents in the USSR. We assume the status of this address has not changed and will notify FOB immediately when this address is to be assigned to a BOB agent.

b. CABATON 1/1A. This address, furnished to BOB per EGFA-25161, 6 February 1959, was assigned to CAESUS per EGBA-56914, 23 April 1959; this assignment was cancelled per BRLN 2170, 10 January 1961. The CABATON 1/1A address was also assigned to CAPRICE-22 per EGBA-61016, 12 January 1960, and CANDARE-18 per BRLN 9099, 4 May 1960; these two assignments remain active.

c. CABATON 5. Furnished to BOB per EGFA-25161, 6 February 1959 (and again by FOB's 02/11 May 1960 cablenote to BOB), this address was assigned to CAROL-1 per BRLN 9503, 26 May 1960, and remains active.

d. CABATON 21. (Formerly CAMITA-4) This address was furnished to BOB per EGFA-25870, 23 April 1959, and subsequently was assigned to BEROUND on 26 October 1959. Because the first test letter sent by BEROUND to this address was not received, BEROUND was issued another accommodation address. FROB-7475, 6 August 1960, informed BOB that the CABATON 21 address was currently assigned to a HIWAY operation and requested no further BOB assignments. We were subsequently informed by FROB-9110, 13 April 1961, that CABATON 21 (at a new address) is again available for assignment to BOB. It is requested that this address be assigned to BOB; starting in June 1961 we will send test letters to this address using the sender's name Karl SCHUMANN. We shall inform you immediately when this address has been assigned to a BOB agent.

e. CABATON 23. Furnished to BOB per EGFA-25156, 3 February 1959, and again by FOB's cablenote of 02/11 May 1960 to BOB, this address was assigned to CATHYROID-3 (formerly CATBIRD-18) per BRLN 9667, 9 June 1960. The CABATON 23 address was also assigned per BRLN 0713, 14 September 1960, to FACATTY-1. The assignment of this address to BOB operations was cancelled (EGBA-68058, 28 March 1961) because of the likely compromise of this address through FACATTY-1.

f. CABATON 24. This address, furnished to BOB per EGFA-25161, 6 February 1959, was assigned to CAVALLIO per EGBA-56154, 23 March 1959. CAVALLIO refugee to the West in September 1959 and FOB was informed per EGBA-61016, 12 January 1960, that this address was no longer being used by CAVALLIO. CASALTY-6 also was assigned this address, in March 1959. BOB cancelled the assignment of this address to BOB operations in January 1961 (EGBA-66851, 25 January 1961) because of the arrest of CASALTY-6. We judge that the address must be considered compromised.

g. CABATON 25. Furnished to BOB per EGFA-25751, 27 March 1959, we reported to FOB that this address was assigned to CAODLES (EGBA-58385, 25 June 1959). EGBA-60875, 25 November 1959, reported that the CABATON 25 address was not given to CAODLES. We cancelled the assignment of this address to BOB in view of CABATON 25's pending emigration to the United States in early 1960.

h. CABATON 26. Furnished to BOB per EGFA-26299, 6 May 1959, this address was assigned to BEROUND (EGBA-61896, 29 February 1960) and also to an FOB BEDOX ZODIAC operation (FROB 6378, 25 February 1960). At Headquarters' request (in view of the FOB BEDOX assignment) this address was not given to BEROUND and the assignment of this address to BOB operations was cancelled. CABATON 26 was again furnished for BOB's use by EGFA-32455, 2 December 1960, and was subsequently assigned to CANALIZE-12. In April 1961 this address was also assigned to CASPUR-2 (see EGBA-68461, 8 June 1961). This address remains active for CANALIZE-12 and CASPUR-2.

i. CABATON 29. Furnished to BOB per FOB's cablenote of 06/05 May 1960, this address was assigned to CATHYROID-1 per BRLN 9587, 2 June 1960, and remains active.

j. CABATON 30. This address was obtained by [] for the exclusive use of CASHARK-3. BRLN 1913, 14 December 1960, notified FOB that CALERIA-29 mailed a test letter in November 1960 to CABATON 30 and we thus considered the address to be compromised. We requested, however, that FOB keep the address active for possible mail from CASHARK-3. Our action re CASHARK-3 has now been completed. We request that the assignment of this address to the CASHARK-3 operation and to BOB be cancelled.

k. CABATON 31. Furnished to BOB by FOB's cablenote of 06/05 May 1960, this address was assigned to CASHIP (now CATHYROID-6) per BRLN 9732, 15 June 1960, and remains active.

l. CABATON 32. Acquired per FOB's cablenote of 06/05 May 1960 to BOB, this address was assigned to CAGAVEL-2 per BRLN 9504, 26 May 1960. This address is still active.

m. CABATON 39. Furnished to BOB via FOB's cablenote of 02/11 May 1960, this address was assigned to CAMITA-6 per BRLN 9493, 25 May 1960, and also to CABEG per BRLN 1849, 9 December 1960. EGBA-66836, 5 January 1961, reported that this address was considered to be compromised (through CABEG), but for CE operational reasons requested that the address be kept active. We now consider our action re CABEG completed and request that the assignment of this address to BOB operations be cancelled.

n. CABATON 41. This address, furnished to BOB per FOB's cablenote of 06/05 May 1960, was assigned to CATHYROID-2 per BRLN 9667, 9 June 1960. Per our 13/19 July 1960 telenote to FOB we cancelled the assignment of this address to CATHYROID-2 as we felt the delay in our receipt of letters from CATHYROID-2 warranted the assignment of another accommodation address to the latter. Per BRLN 0512, 25 August 1960, this address was subsequently assigned to CAWHIM. Although CAWHIM has not yet been given this address, his training will be completed in the near future and the assignment of this address to CAWHIM remains active.

o. CABATON 42. This address, furnished to BOB by FOB's cablenote of 06/05 May 1960, was assigned to CASHAG per BRLN 9627, 6 June 1960. We notified FOB (per BRLN 1913, 14 December 1960) that we considered this address to be compromised because CALERIA-17 mailed a test letter to this address in March 1960. We requested, however, that FOB keep the address active for possible mail from CASHAG. As FOB is already aware (BRLN 0025, 12 July 1960), there is some question as to the bona fides of CASHAG himself. The CASHAG case is not yet clarified and we wish to continue to maintain the address in an active status.

p. CABATON 43. Furnished to BOB by FOB's cablenote of 06/05 May 1960, this address was assigned to CANDARE-18 per BRLN 9667, 9 June 1960, and remains active.

q. CABATON 44. This address, which was furnished to BOB by FOB's cablenote of 06/05 May 1960, has been assigned to AECORBEL-39 (BRLN 9549, 1 June 1960) and AECORBEL-29 (BRLN 9918, 1 July 1960). This address remains active for both AECORBEL-39 and AECORBEL-29.

r. CABATON 45. Furnished to BOB per EGFA-32455, 2 December 1960, for exclusive BOB use, this address is still held in a pending status (per EGFA-33865, 10 April 1961). We continue to regard this address, however, as assigned to BOB and will carry it in a pending status until we have heard that CABATON 45 has returned from his travel in the Bloc countries.

s. CABATON 47. Furnished to BOB per FOB's cablenote of 06/05 May 1960, this address was assigned to CAPEPLUM-1 and CAPEPLUM-2 in June 1960. Both agents refueged to the West, and this address was subsequently assigned to CATHUMP-2 per BRLN 0737, 15 September 1960. This address remains active.

t. CABATON 49. Furnished to BOB by FOB's cablenote of 01/18 July 1960, this address was assigned to CATHYROID-2 as a replacement for the CABATON-41 address (BRLN 0320, 9 August 1960) and remains active.

u. CABATON 50. This address was furnished to BOB by FROB-8429, 23 December 1960, for the exclusive use of AENEON-25 and remains active. Mail from AENEON-25 requires special handling (see BRLN 2014, 23 December 1960).

v. CABATON 51. Obtained by the Soviet Branch of BOB for the exclusive use of AEWALDEN, this address was not receiving the mail sent by AEWALDEN. AEWALDEN was subsequently given a new accommodation address (see BRLN 2823, 19 March 1961). We consider the assignment of this address to BOB as cancelled.

w. CABATON 54. Furnished to BOB per EGFA-31780, 12 October 1960, this address was assigned to CATHUMP-1 per BRLN 1626, 21 November 1960, and is still active.

x. CABATON 55. Furnished to BOB per EGFA-31780, 12 October 1960, this address was assigned to CAVALET-1 and CAVALET-2 per BRLN 1840, 9 December 1960. This address remains active,

y. CABATON 56. This address was forwarded by EGFA-33492, 20 March 1961, as a replacement for the CABATON 23 address (which was compromised) being used by CATHYROID-3. This address was not given to CATHYROID-3 since FROB 9101, 12 April 1961, offered this letterdrop to [] for their use. BRLN 3130, 12 April 1961, concurred with the above action and requested that a replacement address be furnished for CATHYROID-3. We thus consider the assignment of the CABATON 56 address to BOB as cancelled.

z. CABATON 57. Furnished to BOB per EGFA-31780, 12 October 1960, this address was assigned to CADEFIANT per BRLN 1348, 29 October 1960. This address remains active.

CABATON 54	Currently used by CATHUMP-1.
CABATON 55	Currently used by CAVALET-1 and CAVALET-2.
CABATON 57	Currently used by CADEFIANT.
