**NSA-2942, 26 April 1942**

1. In paragraph 2 of reference, NSB stated that they would cease using the British accommodation address assigned to CASIMIRAN-12 and CASIMIRAN-19 as soon as NSB could provide a replacement. Although we realize that the present situation in Berlin may make it impossible to inform the agents of a new address, we propose him as this replacement.

2. He is a BERLIN national student at the University of Berlin and plans to be here for at least three more years. He is married, has two small children, and lives in a three-room apartment. He is not active in student activities and has a small circle of friends. His is a common name in Switzerland and the current British telephone book lists four such names.

3. If NSB accepts this replacement, please notify us which agents will be using the address and how we can describe the operational mail to subject so that he can distinguish it from his personal mail. We also request that NSB send the test letters to the address.
