1. We have carefully considered your suggestion that certain categories of PBPRIMERS be used as accommodation addresses for BOB. Your hesitation in making this suggestion is understandable because, as a general rule, we do not feel such people are suitable as drops.

2. However, the usual objections do not seem to apply to the PBPRIMERS described in reference, and, as you pointed out, their citizenship offers an obvious advantage in terms of motivation.

3. It is our recommendation that MOG go ahead with the program as outlined in reference, subject to the following limitations. The persons selected should have thoroughly Germanic names and should come from that group which was born in Germany, emigrated to PBPRIME and has returned to Germany after retirement.

4. We sincerely appreciate the effort you are making to support BOB's letter drop program.
