REFERENCE(S)

We request that the POAs granted for contact, assessment, and possible recruitment of the following individuals as ILD's be cancelled:

1. The Subject of PROB-0978 ^{Walter HIRZ} refused recruitment. His wife has relatives residing in the Soviet Zone, and they were afraid that some reprisal might be made against them as a result of Subject's activity on our behalf.
2. The Subject of PROB-0979 ^{Herman BLENCK} was not recruited because of a policy decision made not to use recent refugees as ILD's.
3. The Subject of PROB-1096 ^{Ludwig WETTERHAHN} was not recruited because of his fairly recent refugee status.
4. Through further assessment the Case Officer found that the Subject of PROB-1105 ^{Hans PROSCH} was not suited for clandestine activity.
5. Through further assessment the Case Officer found that the Subject of PROB-1107 ^{Karl HEYN} was not suited for clandestine activity.
6. The Subject of PROB-1136 ^{Emil STRAUB} was approached and accepted recruitment. However, his wife later convinced him to change his mind because of her concern that their young son might experience some hardship in the future as a result of their clandestine activity.
7. Further assessment led the Case Officer to conclude that the Subject of PROB-1230 ^{Henry GINDRA} was not suited for clandestine activity.
8. The Subject of PROB-1262 ^{Heinrich VORWERK} refused recruitment on the grounds that he did not wish to become involved in clandestine activity.
9. The Subject of PROB-1449 ^{Hedwig WACHSMUTH} refused recruitment out of fear of reprisal against relatives residing in the Soviet Zone.
10. The Subject of PROB-1558 ^{Ernst GREULICH} was not recontacted since it was decided not to pursue ILD leads living in very small towns.
11. The Subject of PROB-1560 ^{Willy SEYFARTH} initially accepted recruitment but his wife later convinced him to change his mind because she was basically opposed to the clandestine nature of the ILD activity.
12. Further contact with the Subject of PROB-1564 ^{Wilhelm ANGERSTEIN} revealed that he is an extremely outspoken and extroverted individual. It was decided that he would not be suitable for clandestine activity for this reason.
13. A recruitment pitch was made to Subject of PROB-1566 ^{Johes FREITAG} who wanted additional time to think the matter over. He failed to appear for subsequent meetings so we assume he decided against the recruitment proposal.
14. The Case Officer concluded after further assessment that the Subject of PROB-1578 ^{Luitpold VOGEL} was unsuitable for clandestine activity.

15. Further contact with the Subject of PROB-1580 revealed that ^{Eugen MITZEL} he, living in a large rooming house, has no secure means of receiving mail.
16. The Subject of PROB-1593 lives in a small town and the Case Officer, attempting to recontact her, attracted the attention and curiosity of other inhabitants of the town. It has been decided not to pursue LLD's who live in very small towns. ^{Lina HIBSCHENBERGER}
17. The Subject of PROB-1597 refused the recruitment ^{Adolf KLINGMANN} because he was of the opinion that he did not want to become involved in clandestine activity.
18. Further ^{Erich Fritz Ludwig} assessment led the Case Office. ^{BOETCHER} to conclude that the Subject of PROB-1639 was not suited to clandestine activity.
19. The Subject of PROB-1752 ^{Peter DIENER} was not recruited because it was decided not to pursue LLD leads living in very small towns.
20. Further contact with the Subject of PROB-1758 revealed that ^{Alfred GUERTH} because his wife travels to the Soviet Zone occasionally he would not be suitable as an LLD.
