1. In response to FRAN-3234, 13 November 1963, and related traffic, an appropriate letter to DS-102's friend was drafted by BOB, written in native German handwriting by CAPERCH-10 and mailed in East Berlin on 14 January 1964 by CASILO. A German language transcript of the letter is forwarded herewith. The return address is the CABATON-105 address provided by FOB.

2. It is noted that DS-102 apparently erred slightly in spelling the name and giving the street number of his friend. He gave it as Ing. Fritz MAATZ, Kleinmachnow bei Berlin, Karl Marx Strasse 10 or 12. The most current telephone book for this area lists the name and address as Ing. Fritz MAAZ, Kleinmachnow bei Berlin, Karl Marx Strasse 110, and this is how our letter was addressed.

3. CAPERCH-10 wrote the envelope as well as the letter, and hence was exposed to both MAAZ's name and the name and address of CABATON-105. It is believed that CASILO did not learn either name, however. The letter was given to CASILO-1 in an opaque outer envelope, with instructions to mail it at night by removing it from the outer envelope and placing it directly into a letterbox. The reason for this was primarily as a test of CASILO-1. A subsequent L'FLUTING confirmed that CASILO-1 did in fact not learn the name.
