1. When renting safehouses in operational aliases, GRYEN operatives are often called upon to provide an address in Germany. Although the chances of the safehouse owner trying to contact the rentor are minor, the possibility does exist. For this reason, we would request two types of addresses be assigned for the exclusive use of GRYEN, a military unit with an APO address and a German accommodation address. Since we use a multitude of operational aliases, and often are called upon to invent new aliases at a moment's notice, it would be best if the two addresses provided would accept mail in any name and then have it forwarded to Vienna Station with the GRYEN slug. In this way, we would not have to provide you with a listing of aliases used, and also not have to continually revise such a list every two or three months.

2. <u>Military Accommodation address</u>. The operational cover unit provided for the Vienna Station Frankfurt, Germany) (see References A and B) would suit our purpose ideally. If MKTOPAZ has no objection, we would like to extend the use of this cover facility to include receipt of operational support mail. Such operational support mail would include forwarded bills in the case of terminated safehouses, emergency contact to the rentor in case of some exigency, etc. - in short, a facility to back up the usual legend presented by our (GRYEN) operator who rents an apartment in Vienna "As a Dac from Frankfurt who needs a place to rest and meet friends during his infrequent trips to Vienna." Since we are presently terminating several safehouse facilities and do need a backstopping address cable notification of your approval to use the Signal Operations Unit address or an alternate would be appreciated.

3. Civilian Address. This can be an address similar to CABATON-105 (See Reference C); in fact, if only has been assigned the use of this facility you may wish to make arrangements that any mail with the name written c/o (i.e. bei) CABATON=105 be forwarded to Vienna Station for GRYEN. The same criteria as per Paragraph 2 above apply.
