CABATON: [ ] was extremely busy in this program during the reporting period, having taken over the control of CABATON-161 and recruited CABATON-177 and CABATON-181. [ ] CABATON workload, including Subject of DORF 0185 (whom we expect will be recruited if the POA is forthcoming) and CABATON-136 (who is scheduled for takeover) now comprises 16 agents whose residences are located throughout the northern 2/3 of Nordrhein-Westfalen. In addition, [ ] is processing Subject of [ ] (see DIR-65807) as a safehouse keeper. The manner in which [ ] as moved into the support field in the past year is commendable, especially so since he has written all the necessary PRQ and other support correspondence for those agents which he himself has recruited. At the same time, except where specifically directed to turn down cover work, [ ] as maintained his cover at its previously high level.
