On 17 Vebruary 1956, Henard stated that as a result of a decision made by the CEFFARFOL Respective Countities during its menting in October 1953 in the Mague, he was expected to make a trip to Turkey, Labonon, Iran and other Middle East sountries. The primary purpose of this trip, according to Henard, was to exploretthe possibilities of helding TPGANGNAN during the latter part of August 1956 and to brief the Chief of the GEFEARFOL Purkey Office reparting his particular duties. He suggested that every affort be made to influence the CEFEARFUL Rescutive Committee, if that could possibly be done, since almost any manner in which Hemard would be dimeissed for allowed to resign, as the ease may be might dense repurposesions against CADROIT. To support this, he stated that it was his opinion that CADROIT, as an organization, sould sessue a great portion of the credit for reducing outside attacks against Hemard personally, and that whose this organizational support is gone, it would be entirely conseivable that personn't attack would be launched again against Hemord with resulting disclosures (Doctor title, lack of requirements to even precise law, etc) of certain enhancement to CADROLY and its leading functionaries.
