2. Purpose, extent and target of project

The purpose of THIMBER Apparat, as originally conceived, was to establish a para-military organization in the German Temocratic Republic (RDR) for E & E and other stav-behind resistance activities in case of war with the Soviet mion. To attain these aims it was thought expedient to establish within the Investigative Committee of Free Jurists (TPEMBER) a section devoted to the establishment and development of a para-military apparat. This apparat was to utilize the facilities, likes and contacts of TPEMBER, but would be divorced from THIMBER's own activities. The apparat was to be headed by a former officer with the recessary qualifications and background in intelligence activities. However, he was to be subordinate to br. Friedenau, Thief of THIMBER, although not operationally responsible to him. It was considered advisable to attach the apparat to TPEMBER, because THIMBER could provide a cover for the apparat activities, and its reputation as a known resistance organization would attract volunteers for resistance work.

The desirability of adding a para-military organization to the effective P/W cold war activities performed by TPEMBER since 1949 has repeatedly been questioned by DYCLAIN officials, including Mr. Fisher, who feared that the establishment of the apparat would distract TREMBER from its primary cold war mission. In addition, the fact that TREMBER is a RIS target was felt to incresse the security risk involved in establishing the net.

The project got under may in the summer of 1911 after some months of preliminary activities. In the beginning funds were passed to the Apparat through Friedenau and he considered himself the head of the Apparat even after the physical and administrative separation of the two organizations last summer. As of two weeks ago, the truncat has become entirely incereadent of friedenau except for the fact that it does maintain a lisison officer (Erich Holtdorf, a former naval captain) to TEXMBER.

3. Security of project and personnel connected with it

The Apparat was a part of TPEMBER until a few months ago; therefore the security of the project under review is closely related to the security of TPEMBER. The following is a short account of the major security rami-fications of TPEMBER Apparat:

Friedenau was briefed on our 2 & plans by (and selected and recruited former Admiral Konrad Patzig to head the Free Jurist's paramilitary adjunct. Patzig failed in his recruitment efforts allegedly because of our high requirements. Patzig was then found to be unacceptable because of his personal connections with von Gehlen, chief of ZIPPER, and his official status as a paid agent with that organization. Patzig was dropped in January 1952 and it is believed that he was aware of the reason for the severance of the apparat's connections with him. Formerly TPMFER had two office buildings, one of which was used by the Apparat and the Selfare Jection of TPME?. It but one (radio operator) of the 7 existing staff members of the Apparat had their offices in this building from Deptember 1951 until June 1957, when the Apparat moved to its new location under the cover of the "Institute for Industrial Hygiene".
