- b. The principal agent informed the Berlin Operations Base that one of the East Zone agents of the Apparat was arrested by East German Security police on 6 January 1953. This arrest may be the result of the breaking of another agent who was picked up last November in a routine security raid. Efforts to warn all other Apparat members who may be endangered are under way. A therough security investigation is being conducted.
- c. The movement of CADRASTIC headquarters from West Berlin to West Germany is held up pending selection of a suitable cover and establishment of proper coordination with the West German authorities.
