NOTE: This operation is engaged in developing stay-behind assets for wartime tasks consisting of Escape and Evasion, limited sabotage, drop zones, and W/T facilities. In order to achieve these objectives it is organizing and training assets during the cold war period. At present it has 76 cadre groups which are distributed geographically in accordance with the pattern of population concentration in the East Zone.

b. Escape and Evasion preparations were held to a minimum pending final completion of the security reorganization which was reported previously.

c. Although sabotage planning was held to a minimum in view of the current reorganization, ll groups totalling 76 men have been earmarked for this work. These groups are located in industrial areas with a particularly heavy concentration in the Dresden district. CADROWN has also prepared a good general study of sabotage possibilities in the GDR.

d. During the reporting period there were 16 W/T students in training and 5 candidates were being processed.

e. The number of drop zones which have been selected and manned by CADROWN stands at 14.

f. One W/T man was arrested in the GDR for unknown reasons. A full report will be made upon receipt of the field investigation findings.
