11. Summary

NOTE: This operation is engaged in developing stay-behind asset for wartime tasks consisting of Escape and Evasion, limited sabotage, drop zones, and W/T facilities. In order to achieve these objectives, it is organizing and training assets during the cold war period. At present it has 76 cadre groups which are distributed geographically in accordance with the pattern of population concentration in the East Zone.

b. Summary of Activities.

(1) Eleven members of the CADROWN network were arrested during the reporting period. Two members were reportedly to have been arrested for black market activities, three for allegedly warning the leading employees of a radio firm of their impending arrests during the 17 June riots. Six others were arrested for unknown reasons. As a result of these arrests, four members fled to West Berlin and seven members were immediately warned of the danger, although three of these were later arrested.

(2) A full investigation by the German Mission is continuing. Several leads are being followed; the most serious involves a possible penetration of the covert network headquarters.

(3) A new location for the W/T school has been found.

(4) The number of drop zones remains at 17.
