1. Frankfurt files contain no identifiable traces on persons mentioned in reference, with the exception of the following possible traces:
 - a. According to MEBA-2788, dated 28 Feb. 1950, a Richard SCHULTZE, born about 1890, in Brandenburg is an alleged German MVD informant.
 - b. RT-419-49, dated 5 April 1949, states that Richard SCHULTZ @ "Angerwunder" is an MVD- informant in Kreis Angerwunde.
 - c. We have voluminous traces on an Erich RESCHKE, which are summed up in the following references:- According to WCPA-2288, RSU/Ops/207, Brit Sum.13, dated August 1948, Erich RESCHKE is a Communist functionary in Hamburg. He was interned by the Nazis in 1933, and remained in concentration camps until 1945. He was a block leader in Bushenwald, and brutal in his treatment of fellow prisoners. Before his appointment to SA, was police chief in Thüringen and friend of BUSSE, Thüringian Minister for Internal Affairs, who was also a Block Leader in Bushenwald. He was suspected of engaging in murder of two Communists, HAY and MARL. He was reported to have spent some time in Russia and to speak Russian fluently. He was responsible for training of personnel selected for SED Informationsdienst.
