- 1. Frankfurt files contain the following possible traces on individuals mentioned in referenced disputch: Y LX
 - a. In March 1947 submitted information on Willi BERREWS, Major Comeral in the German Army who had been smarded the Intight's Gress. At the end of the war he lived in Kamens, Samony. He had been kept in the active service despite his 50 percent Jorish origin, because of his wasmal value to the service. During the war, however, he was discharged because of sucposted participation in the 20 July conspiracy and because of open criticism of Mither's generalship.

When the Russians occupied Kamens, they appointed subject as chief of the county police on the bashs of his anti-facist record. In July 1946 subject was arrested, brought to Bantsem and later to Frankfurt/Oder, where he apparently still kept (as of 1947). Subject's wife informed source that she feared arrest with her children by the Ressians and forced to accompany her bushend to Russia. Because of this fear, she fled to Berlin, but at our in-sistence she returned to Kampha. During her stay in Berlin she lived with her sister-in-law Baroness von Pressentin, Berlin/Charlottenburg, Leibnitsstrasse 44.

It is suspected that General BERRES is being indostrinated by the Bussians. to be later given a key job in the Germany Ministry of Interior or any declar high-level police function. It is suggested that his name by kept in mind for such future possibilities.

- f. Hans LANGE: (The following information is taken from the card as the report is not available to this office.) Returned to Germany in January 1948 and registered as SED member. Old communist and member of Rote Frantkampferbund. In AZ under Hitler, released to join Penal Bn 500. Deserted to Russians in Poland during 1945. Took antifa courses in Riga. Police thief in Chemical camps. Supposed to be assigned to police duties on returns: (ESC-57, 10 January 1948).
- g. Ress Erick LANGE: Oberhausen, Katharinenstrasse 160/III, state official of the UAPD. (07APG-9735, 25 August 1952.)
- h. A Hans LANGE is given as a character reference by C and C hower the documents are not available here. A Mans Otto LANGE is given by LOUISE as a character reference, but these documents are also not available. All are deppted agents.
- 1. A Farl Offo is listed in RGBA-5719, 30 June 1953, as the cousin of Paul DANYSON, relegio who passed through REBOP house. Offo is described as 27 years old and living Dertunne, Berghofen, Berghofenstr. 140.
- j. Karl Offo, born sa 1914, living Doellnitserstr. 3, Malle, is described in 5102 CNOPO, 13 May 1952, as an informer for the MKVD.
- k. Karl Induis Offo, born 22 December 1892; German; last address known, Altenbergerstr. 60, Bresden appears on the ID EUCON Dropped Agents List of 20 July 1949 as being dropped for insyttade.
- 1. A Kerl Offo is eard/to RP-222-52, 20 November 1952 filed Bundesrepublik Bureaus and Ministries, but the document is not available.
- m. Near Priedrich SCHORNFEID, born 18 April 1923 at Merseburg appears in a list of Identity Requests, dated 1 April 1952, submitted to this headquarters by Eq. MOSCH.
- n. Georg Priodrich SCHORNFKLD, born 18 April 1923; last known address, Berlin Mass-toufelstr. AO c/o Weber Berlin/Tempelhof appears on the Dropped Agents List of 16 July 1953 as being compressed.
- o. Shujest of paragraphs "m" and "mR is the subject of a CIG Alert Letter, dated & June 1953, which was forwarded to your office under BISA-1410.
- p. A Georg SCHOMPKLDER is mentioned in SERA-2539 and SERLM-7617.
- q. The 19th individual listed on the first page to attachment of EGBA-4745 has a similar name and identical place of residence as GADROWN/JBRADDLE JB-92.
- r. Otto ZANDER, born on 1912, living Berlin/Schoenepeiff, Spreestr. J. Leading member of MDPD. Attitude is 150% ppq-East. One of the principal MDPD agents

infiltrating into West Germany from the DER. (BSLA-2771)

- e. MiB-6151, dated 20 April 1948, is not available therefore the following information is available from the card: Otto ZAMDER, on staff of "Hational Zeitung", a SMA licensed paper which made its initial appearance 22 March 1948. Was the press chief of HJ cultural office.
- t. ET-639-53, dated 3 July 1953, subject: Trade Megatiations Detween Egypt and the East German Government has as its source one <u>Frits TREYER</u>. He is an illegal border crosser from the Seviet Zone of Germany. Born 7 July 1926. From December 1951 until March 1953 he was employed with "DIA". During this period he worked in the metal cutting-tools sales office.
- u. BAOR 30, dated October 1948 (not available here following is cird trace) reports one Hermann VOIST, Boumandour der Schupe, Breaden/Vildermann, Schmetsen-hofstr. as a member of the KPD/SED. Born on 1913 in Westphalia. Oberfeldwebel in 1944. Taken as PW by Russians and attended Artifa Camp. Member of the HEPD. May 1945 Kommandour der Schupe, later President of Police, Broaden. September of 1948 transferred to Abt Schupe at the DVdl.
- v. A card contained in Frankfurt files on Armin IEIL (Dipl. Ing. reads as follows:

"Heschwitz bei Tetschen/Elbe Dir: Kenkordia-Spinnerei Stehr & Co. Heschwitz/Elbe AR: Kammgarnspinnerei Stehr & Co., Leipzig Leipziger Wellkammerei, Leipzig Woll-Wascherei u. Kammerei, Behren/Hannover Kitgl. Sudetenl'endischer Beirat der Deutschen Bank, Berlin"

- w. MSHA-6340, dated 3 January 1951, List of Communist agents in Western Zones, (The list, of an undetermined value, somes from the "ORGA. 10", which reportedly is a Communist organization located in Leipzig. This organization has the cover name of "Philatelia Society TIETE.") limbs a Dr. Med. Paul FRIEDRICH, born 1909. Ja Satow Krais Rostock.
- x. EGB1-2500, dated 13 January 1953 and EGB1-2581 forward as an attachment a list of the percentel roster of the Leipzig-Engeledoerf Behrmeisterel as obtained from BELFEY 9. One Walter STEINBACH, been 20 October 1901, Grimma, Hackauer-strasse 1, Zugfuchrer, appears on this list.
- 2. There are no identifiable traces on other individuals mentioned in reference.
- 3. Please advise this office if any of the possible traces given above are identical with individuals named in referenced dispetch,
