1. The following name trace results are submitted for your information and appropriate action:

- ✓* NVM 279 *Code name* COM - No record.  
 GIG - Stated to an American intelligence agency in September 1952 that he had been a member of the Untersuchungsamt Freiwirtschaftlicher Juristen (Research Dept. of the Free Jurists) in Berlin (dates not indicated.) Subject also stated that the Ministerium Staatssicherheit (Ministry of State Security - East Zone of Germany) (MSS) arrested him twice (dates not indicated) and that he was called a "reactionary" and "West Agent" by the MSS. Subject stated that he escaped being arrested a third time by fleeing to West Berlin (date not indicated). (F-3) (Confidential)
- ✓* NVM 226 *Code name* COM - No record.  
 GIG - Subject's name appears on Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2 List of Dropped Informants, Annex A-13, dated 19 December 1951. Reason for discharge: ineptitude. (Confidential).
- ✓* NVM 653 *Code name* COM - No record.  
 GIG - A trace is held on (NVM-653), born 24 Nov. 1898 in SUESSEBACH, who was a member of the NSDAP from 1932 to 1945; a member of the Deutsche Arbeitsfront (German Labor Front) (DAF) from 1934 to 1938; and a member of the National Sozialistische Volkswohlfahrt (National Socialist Welfare Organization) (NSV) from 1934 to 1945. (Unvaluated; Confidential)
- ✓* NVM 12 *Code name* COM - NSKA-29743, 31 May 1951: Karlsruhe files contained an interrogation report on one (NVM-12) Unteroffizier and member of the Nachrichten-regiment 506, who played an important part in the installation and

maintenance of radio nets between agents and Abwehr headquarters throughout Southeast Europe and in Germany. The interrogation report gives no further data on this man.

CIC - No record.

2. CIC and COM files reveal no record on the following CABROWN Group Leaders:

3. Please note that reference dispatch states that COM files reveal no record of HVM 12, whereas we now find we do have a record of HVM 12, as shown in para 1 above.
