CADRON/Transmission of German Files

1. We are forwarding as separate cover Attachments A, B and C three of the original German language CADRON files on CADRON groups and women which were described in sub-paragraph 1c of Reference dispatch. These folders bear the CADRON file numbers AZ 600-610, AZ 611-620, and AZ 621-630.

2. Due to the termination of CADRON, these files are no longer necessary in BOB and should, therefore, be removed to an area less exposed to enemy capture than Berlin. Since they might conceivably prove of future value in the event of war, however, you may wish to arrange for their storage in some suitable area.

3. The files are being forwarded piecemeal due to their bulk.

4. Particular attention is called to separate cover attachment D, which contains a key to the filing system used by CADRON. This key will enable the user to find any given group or woman file quickly and conveniently.
