## PROJECT RENEWAL

### a. Current Objectives

~~Identity-1~~ CAGENERAL project is a clandestine communication support project and, as such, has no specific RMD objectives and targets. The project provides for the maintenance of certain live accommodation addresses and post office box facilities considered essential to support the operational activities of MOG as well as related support activities of other stations and bases. Continuation of this project is considered justified in view of the continuing operational need for the postal accommodation communications facilities provided.

### b. Changes

1. The latest approved project renewal for ~~Identity-1~~ CAGENERAL project, covering the period 1 November 1960 through 31 October 1961, provided for a total of 14 live addresses and 14 post boxes. A gradual reduction for various reasons during the past year and a review of current operational requirements reduced these numbers to 11 live addresses and 8 post boxes. This renewal request, therefore, provides for the current number of existing facilities which should be sufficient for the renewal period involved unless operational requirements change considerably. In this event, provision is also included for possible additional acquisitions.

2. Case officer responsibility for this project was transferred to <sup>use true</sup> ~~Identity-1~~ CAGENERAL after the recent PCS departure from MOG of <sup>es!</sup> ~~Identity-1~~ CAGENERAL. A review of the pertinent files indicates that efforts were continued during the past project year to switch certain operational correspondence from post boxes to more recently acquired live drops, to consolidate postbox holdings where operationally feasible, and to eliminate boxes assigned to dead and unproductive operations. Two safehouse apartment facilities located in the appropriate military Kaserne area are also being utilized as postal accommodation addresses for this project with no actual cost to ~~Identity-1~~ CAGENERAL project. <sup>mp</sup>

4. No new live addresses were acquired during the past project year.

c. Intelligence Production

~~Identity-1~~ CAGENERAL project is designed essentially to provide operational support facilities only, therefore, no intelligence product is expected due to the support nature of the project.

d. Effectiveness

~~In view of the recent transfer of case officer responsibility and the lack of first hand familiarity with the operational problems encountered in the past, it is somewhat difficult for the present case officer to comment adequately on the effectiveness of the Identity-1 CAGENERAL project or to review any significant operational events of the past period which have not been adequately documented. It is reasonable to assume that the project has fulfilled satisfactorily all MOG operational requirements for postboxes and live addresses. Available facilities are also being utilized to support current BOB, ARB, and Austrian Station operations.~~

At the present time, there is no reserve of unused live addresses which would be available to service the requirements of large-scale operations on a crash basis. Because of the many problems related to spotting, recruiting, obtaining operational clearances, and agent-handling problems, we are hopeful that operational requirements may continue to be met adequately with our existing facilities in view of current MOG manpower limitations.

e. Problems

There were no known problems of a security, cover, or control nature during the past period.

f. Liaison

No liaison relations with other governments and intelligence or security services are required in the administration of ~~Identity-1~~ <sup>the</sup> CAGENERAL project.

g. Interagency Coordination

No coordination with <sup>Other American</sup> ~~ODYKIS~~ agencies was required during the past period nor is coordination of this nature envisaged for the period of renewal involved.

## h. Plans

The gradual reduction of the MOG personnel complement and a related realignment of operational activity has resulted in a gradual reduction in the number of available live address and postbox facilities. It is felt that the number of facilities currently maintained should be adequate to support current and future needs, at least during the period covered by this project renewal request.

## i. Costs
