REQUEST FOR RENEWAL OF PROJECT CAGENERAL

1. Current Objectives: CAGENERAL Project is a clandestine communications support project and, as such, has no specific RMD objectives and targets. The project provides for the maintenance of certain live mail accommodation addresses and post office box facilities which are essential to support the operational activities of the Munich Operations Base as well as activities of other stations and bases. The project currently includes 13 live letter drops and 10 post office boxes. A list of the currently employed live letter drops and the operations they support is as follows:

2. Changes:

- a. The goals set in the last project renewal have been scaled down in order to remain consistent with current operational requirements. It has become evident that a number of live letter drops have declined in usefulness through compromise or long years of service. The agent manpower goals for CAGENERAL in the forthcoming project year have therefore been set at 20 live letter drops; of these, approximately seven will represent additional letter drops required to satisfy Munich Operations Bases operational needs, while approximately five will be replacements for live letter drops which are to be terminated within the near future.
- b. Three new live letter drops have been recruited since the last project renewal was submitted; these are CAGENERAL-20, -23, and -25. One live letter drop, CAGENERAL-18, was terminated during the current project year and CAGENERAL-2, -5, -7, -11, and -14 are scheduled for early termination.
- c. Two additional post office boxes were acquired during the project year. Munich Operations Base has also been using two safe apartments located within a US Army installation as low-security mail boxes at no actual cost to CAGENERAL. Since one of these apartments was recently turned back to the US Army, one of the CAGENERAL post boxes was thereby lost as well.
- 3. Intelligence Production: CAGENERAL Project is designed essentially to provide secure operational support facilities. Therefore, no intelligence is produced.
- 4. <u>Liaison</u>: No liaison relations with other governments and intelligence or security services are required in the administration of this project.
- 5. Interagency Coordination: No coordination with other American agencies was required during the past period nor is coordination of this nature anticipated for the renewal period involved.
- 6. Effectiveness: During the past current project year, the CAGENERAL mechanism has proven effective and reliable. To our knowledge, all mail has been received and put promptly into the proper hands.

- 7. Problems: There were no known problems of a security cover, or control nature during the past current project year.
- 8. Plans: Munich Operations Base's current operational requirements will necessitate the recruitment of approximately 12 new live letter drops early in the forthcoming project year.
