SUBJECT: Amendment of Project CAGENERAL

1. Project CAGENERAL was approved for the period
1 February 1964 through 31 January 1965 in the amount of

for the current project year. This increase
is needed to effect termination and resettlement of
CAGENERAL-2 and his wife.

- 2. CAGENERAL-2 is now 75 years old, ill, and unable to perform duties for CIA. His pension from the West German Federal Government is small. It is desired to set up a small annuity for the couple, and to pay for their move to new quarters in a small town away from Munich where they wish to live.
- CAGENERAL-2 began his work for CIA with an assignment from the Berlin Base in April 1952 to be a courier across the Czech border through East Germany. Through no fault of his own he was arrested in July 1952 and imprisoned for four and one half years by the East Germans for "conspiracy against the State". He was released in December 1956. The couple have been an administrative responsibility for CIA since this Since October 1958 the Munich Base has used them as safehouse keepers and as a letter drop, but they are now too old to continue these duties. Over the years the Berlin and Munich Bases have paid the couple various sums totaling \$6,745.00, exclusive of salaries to CAGENERAL-2 for operational support duties. These sums were given as partial but not complete compensation for the hardships suffered by the agent and his wife, and to help offset the loss of CAGENERAL-2's property in East Germany, which was confiscated at the time of his arrest and which he claims was valued at \$9,375.00.



- 4. A permanent settlement of our obligations to this couple is desirable and we propose the following expenditures to bring this about:
  - 1) Moving and resettling the couple and their household effects from Munich to the town of Nonnweiler where they wish to live in retirement

2) Provision of an annuity policy through WUMUTUAL which would give the couple a guaranteed income of DMW 100 (\$25) per month for 11 years, supplementing their present West German government pension of \$146.00 per month
