PROJECT RENEWALCURRENT OBJECTIVES

1. The CAGENERAL project provides support to all Munich Operations Base clandestine operations which involve open mail communications. CAGENERAL also provides support to certain operations under the control of Headquarters, Berlin Operations Base, and other stations and bases. The project currently provides for 20 live letter drops and 12 post office boxes. A detailed report on the currently employed live letter drops and the operations they support is being forwarded as Attachment to this project outline.

CHANGES

2. During the current project year, all live letter drops who are no longer considered useable because of compromise or other factors have been terminated, i.e., CAGENERALS-2, -5, -7, -12, -14 and -23. CAGENERAL-20 was recently compromised and he will be terminated as of the end of the current project year. Five replacements have been recruited since the last project renewal was submitted, i.e., CAGENERALS-26, -27, -28, -29 and -30.

3. Four post office boxes were terminated during the project year because of their long use and probable compromise. No new post office boxes were acquired. Munich Base continues to use one safe apartment located within an ODIBEX installation as a low-security mail box at no cost to Project CAGENERAL.

4. CAROAST-1 resigned 29 February 1964 and [ ] assumed the responsibility for servicing the CAGENERAL post boxes. [ ] departed Munich PCS in July 1964 and [ ] was assigned the responsibility for contacting and assessing live letter drop leads.

PRODUCTION -- Not applicable to this project.

EFFECTIVENESS

5. During the current project year, the CAGENERAL mechanism has proven effective and reliable. To our knowledge, all mail has been received and delivered promptly to the proper persons.

PROBLEMS

6. There were no known problems of a security, cover, or control nature during the current project year.

LIAISON/INTER-AGENCY COORDINATION -- Not applicable to this project.

PLANS

7. Munich Base anticipates that it will require approximately 20 live letter drops during the coming project year. Of this number, 11 of the present live letter drops will be retained and 9 additional ones are to be recruited. [ ] is presently interviewing CAGENERAL candidates under non-Intelligence cover and will request POA's on those considered suitable for further assessment and recruitment.

8. An effort will also be made to obtain five new post office boxes to replace the five now held by Munich Base.

COSTS

9. The total sum of [ ] was approved by Headquarters for the current project year, i.e., [ ] at the time of the last project renewal, and [ ] per EGMW-13902, dated 19 August 1964, for purposes of final termination and resettlement of CAGENERAL-2. As of 30 November 1964, approximately of this sum had been expended in the field, and it is assumed that

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approximately \$3,750.00 was expended by Headquarters for the purchase of the CAGENERAL-2 annuity policy, making a total expenditure as of 30 November 1964 of           . It is estimated that by the end of the project year, an additional \$400.00 will have been expended, making a total of           .

CAGENERAL LIVE LETTER DROPS AS OF 30 NOVEMBER 1964

CAGENERAL-11 [ ]

Date recruited: 29 October 1959  
Salary: DM [ ] per month

C-11 is being retained as an emergency link to be used when directed in BOB's CAMOLAR-1 (formerly CASPUR-1) operation. He received no operational mail during the current project year. However, he was tested quarterly and delivered the test letters promptly.

CAGENERAL-13 [ ]

Date recruited: 23 August 1960  
Salary: DM [ ] per month

C-13 is assigned to receive mail in the AECHITCHAT operation. He has received no operational mail since May 1962; however, he delivers test letters promptly. Headquarters, in EGMW-13770, requested that this address be retained for an indefinite period.

CAGENERAL-15 [ ]

Date recruited: 21 August 1960  
Salary: DM [ ] per month

C-15 is assigned to the AENUCLEUS operation. No mail was received in this operation until February 1964, when AENUCLEUS came to the West and contacted MOB by writing a postcard to subject accommodation address. C-15 subsequently received a letter from AENUCLEUS. The address is being retained pending further developments in the AENUCLEUS case.

CAGENERAL-17 [ ]

Date recruited: 9 November 1960  
Salary: DM [ ] per month

C-17 is assigned to the BOB CAESUS-1 operation. She has delivered all operational mail promptly.

CAGENERAL-20 [ ]

Date recruited: 5 December 1962  
Salary: DM [ ] per month

C-20 was assigned to the DMGRAIL operation from July 1963 until August 1964, when the operation was terminated. From September 1964 to 4 November 1964, he was used as an accommodation address by DEMARKS, an outside-to-outside operation. The address was then issued to [ ] a prospective CASLUG agent, who reported it to CATIDE and possibly also to the MfS upon his return to East Germany. It is planned to terminate C-20 as of 31 January 1965.

CAGENERAL-21 [ ]

Date recruited: 23 November 1962  
Salary: DM [ ] per month

C-21's first assignment was to receive mail from BESTUD, who was contacted on a trip to the West under non-intelligence cover. No mail was ever received from BESTUD and permission to cancel the assignment was granted in EGBA-77453.

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S E C R E T

The C-21 address was then assigned to CASAMPLE-5 for use on a one-time basis. It is not considered compromised through this assignment.

In response to EGMW-13947, dated 2 September 1964, Subject's address was issued to DMSHRED, who was contacted while visiting a FBPRIME relative and tentatively agreed to work for KUBARK in DMLET.

CAGENERAL-25

Date recruited: 17 January 1963  
Salary: DM ( ) per month

C-25 is assigned to receive mail from DMHUSH. (See DIR 74898, 11 Oct. '63). To date, no mail has been received. However, Subject has performed well in the handling of test letters.

CAGENERAL-26

Date recruited: 17 March 1964  
Salary: DM ( ) per month

C-26 receives mail from CASAMPLE-1 and has performed well.

CAGENERAL-27

Date acquired: 1 June 1964  
Salary : DM 100.00

C-27 has been assigned to the DIKING operation. To date, no operational mail has been received; however, he has performed well in the handling of test correspondence.

CAGENERAL-28

Date recruited: 2 January 1964  
Salary: DM ( ) per month

No operation assigned. Subject has performed well in the handling of test correspondence.

CAGENERAL-29

Date recruited: 5 June 1964
