- 2. Hadderen returned to C theletters which C had earlier delivered re CARCARMA 2's divorce action-marked Dr. H. to E.S. 26/12 copy of affidavit, E.S. to C.RX31/1. C to E.S. 2/2, E.S. to C 3/2, max E.S. to Dr. H. 3/24 and two letters from \$ARCARMA 2 to mother-in-law. We have copies.

- 4. In answer to queries C gavethe following info re the CARCARAMA 2 matter:
 - a. Heither Fil. nor his wife are inchlanguations involved in the divorce action at all. It appears that CARCARANA 2 has said nothing in Fran re either person.

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- b. The Fran lawyers wrote E.S. in detail what CARCARANA 2 had told them re her and her activities wis-a-wis C and KUBARK. C thought that this meant that CARCARANA 2 had not told the Fran court this info. Pepin thought it possible that she had told the court, referring to her letter to her manking mother-implant("Das Gericht macht es hadr sehr schwer sich scheiden su lassen, daher also die Verzoegerung, und die viele Schweiberei. Die wollen alles ganz genau wissen und ich muste leider alles genau angeben da man sonst nicht scheidet.
