Date, Time, and Place of Meeting: 10 Feb 55, 1900-2130, CARBOHYDRATE'S Apt

1. CARBOHYDRATE delivered the following written material:

- a. Four excerpted reports re SSD. For CART.
- b. One report re KVP.
- c. Security regulations for the new building (L30). The following will be established in the new buildings:

Flüchtlingstelle-Bluhm, Erben, Maurer, Goerner plus secrye.
Fran Moeller, Frl. Liebig, and Frau Maurer

CACHARADE-----Viebig and Norden, plus secrye. Frau Ahrent.

Others-----Dr. Wolf and Fran Bluhm, Herler and Frau
Martini,

The following files and no others will be in L30:

- Refugee Outachten (about 30 file folders)
- CACHARADE cards containing names of arrestees and near relatives --low security.

Specifically, there will be no MA cards, B or Bu cards in L 30. The B and Bu cards have been moved to the old Pressestelle, Rm 17 of the old building.

- d. Copy of report by MA 'Eiler Bracke' to effect S. H. and R. of Luft VOFO shotax, which was published by press section. To answer ZIPPER query. CARBO noted the info had come to Leutwein ~~Susselmann~~ who later found out MA had given some info to Telegraph and RIAS. The MA is now regarded with some suspicion, therefore.

2. Pepin returned to C the letters which C had earlier delivered re GARGARANA 2's divorce action--~~Dr. W.~~ to E.S. 26/1, copy of affidavit, E.S. to C 31/1, C to E.S. 2/2, E.S. to C 3/2, and E.S. to Dr. W. 3/2, and two letters from GARGARANA 2 to mother-in-law. We have copies.

3. Pepin also returned files for Bode. v B. and Vogel.

4. In answer to queries C gave the following info re the GARGARANA 2 matter:

- a. Neither Frl. nor his wife are ~~involved~~ involved in the divorce action at all. It appears that GARGARANA 2 has said nothing in Fran re either person.

- b. The Fran lawyers wrote E.S. in detail what CARCARANA 2 had told them re her and her activities vis-a-vis C and KUBARK. C thought that this meant that CARCARANA 2 had not told the Fran court this info. Papin thought it possible that she had told the court, referring to her letter to her mother-in-law ("Das Gericht macht es sehr schwer sich scheiden zu lassen, daher also die Verzögerung, und die viele Schreiberel. Die wollen alles ganz genau wissen und ich musste leider alles genau angeben da man sonst nicht scheidet. Mein Rechtsanwalt hat mit dem Præsidenten gesprochen und ihm gesagt, dass alle damit einverstanden sind, und trotz dem will man nicht scheiden") CARBO thought this meant only that CARCARANA 2 had ~~not~~ given the info to her lawyers, he agreed, however, that the matter was not entirely clear in this respect.
- c. C had testified for CARCARANA 2~~ix~~ during her refugee processing in his personal capacity, and not as an official of or in the name of CADROIT. ~~It is not clear whether C was acting in his personal capacity or as an official of CADROIT.~~ C agreed to get the HNAV file on CARCARANA 2 if he can.
- d. C has not yet discussed the divorce action with Ledell or Henard. When [] said that C should feel perfectly free to do so, indicating that [] would prefer to have this done, C showed reluctance, stating the matter was only a private matter (s) as yet, and not a "CADROIT matter". It could become a CADROIT matter, but had not yet done so. [] did not insist that C report the affair to Henard and Ledell, only COMMENT: C is obviously afraid that if Ledell and Henard hear of the matter, their reaction will be that C has ~~been~~ ~~mentioned~~ ~~in~~ ~~the~~ ~~press~~ ~~by~~ ~~his~~ ~~past~~ ~~actions~~, which are now being documented in court, ~~and~~ ~~that~~ ~~the~~ ~~matter~~ ~~is~~ ~~being~~ ~~made~~ ~~public~~ the tie between KUPIRE and CADROIT. [] took ~~some~~ occasion to assure C now as before of full support by KUBARK in his work. [] thinks it would be advisable to inform ~~Henard~~ ~~and~~ ~~Ledell~~ ~~of~~ ~~the~~ ~~affair~~, preferably by having CARBO report the matter himself. This matter will be raised again with CARBO after he has had a little time to chew on it.
- ADDITION: C gave the following info to show that the ~~matter~~ ~~of~~ ~~CARCARANA2~~ case has nothing to do with CADROIT: C recruited CARCARANA before 1 April 53 when he began work with CADROIT and saw CARCARANA only socially thereafter. (C had been approached for the CADROIT job initially as of 1 ~~Jan~~ 53—before the recruitment. During this period CARBO was a refugee and "private man")
5. C also delivered a two page report on G. H., traced for REDCAP, and negative traces on Horst. P.
