1. It is requested that the CATRANSIT Project be terminated effective 30 june 1969 - the end of the Project Year. The Project has surlived its usefulness in that its primary function - to maintain a pool of trained courier assets for operational support tasks in East Berlin and East Germany - has been assumed by the CABUS Project.

Status of Commitments/Disposition of Assets

2. With the exception of CARCASSA-80, there are no outstanding financial or other commitments to any of the Project assets. Beginning with FY 70, CARCASSA-80 and the safebouse currently administered under the Project will be funded from the CARCASSA Project. Other current Project personnel, all of whom were inactive during the Current Project Year, will be screened for other possible uses within the German Station - some will probably be offered to Frankfurt Base as CABATON assets, the remainder will be dropped.
