



Angola: Holden Roberto's influence in the nationalist struggle may be diminished as a result of the agreement for an alliance, including a unified military command of all Angolan factions, which was reportedly signed at the recent conference of African nationalists in Accra. It is still unclear how the agreement will work or how binding it will be. It was signed by the representative of the Democratic party of Angola (PDA) -- a member of Roberto's coalition provisional government--as well as by President Nkrumah and the president of the Communist-supported Popular Movement for the Liberation of Angola (MPLA). Roberto reportedly does not consider the PDA signature as binding his provisional government to honor the agreement, but he will be unable to ignore it completely. The agreement reportedly commits Nkrumah to provide Soviet-made arms to the Angolan nationalists.
