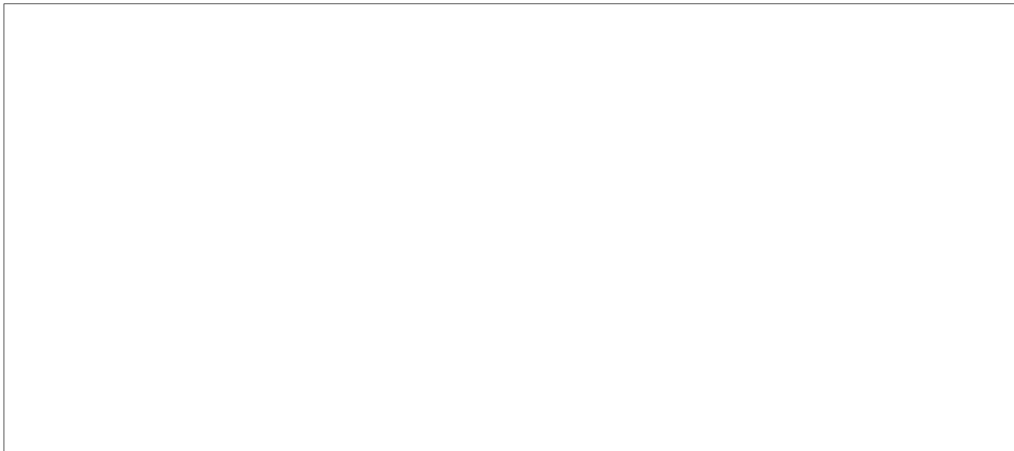

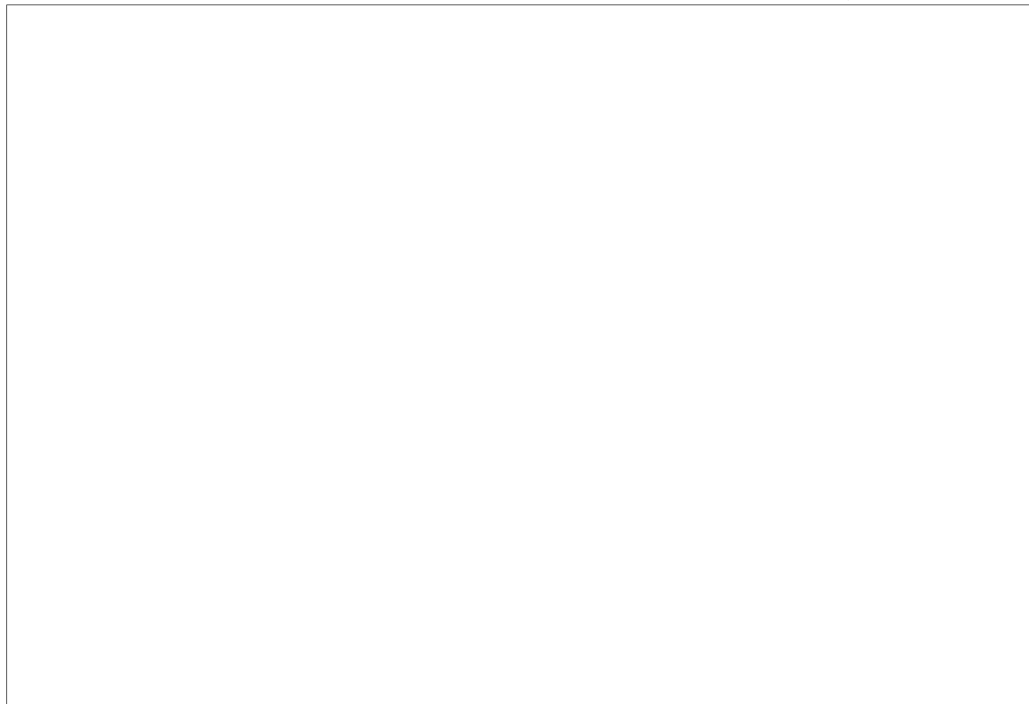

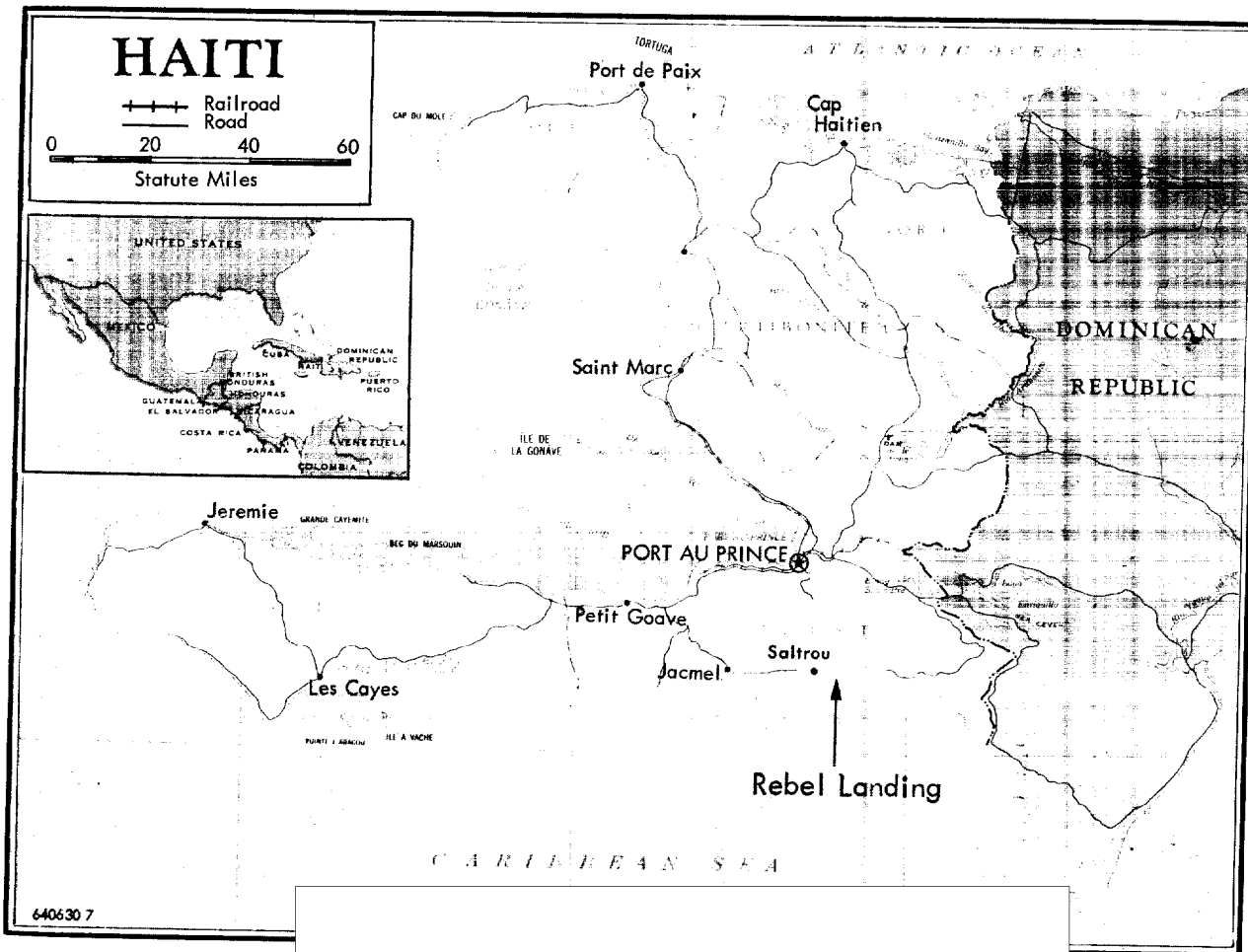

*Haiti: A small group of rebels has landed on the Haitian southeastern coast near Saltrou, [redacted]

[redacted]

[redacted] the rebels left the Dominican Republic on 27 June. [redacted]

[redacted] there are 30 in the group, and that they are equipped with small arms and explosives. They plan to blow up bridges and police posts beginning sometime this week.

[redacted]

Since the first indications of the landing at Saltrou, the Haitian armed forces (FAd'H) and the civil militia (VSN) have been placed on alert.

At best the invaders can only hope to reach the rugged mountains nearby, and carry out guerrilla activities. The FAd'H and the VSN would be hard pressed if there were further landings. In any event there does not appear to be an immediate danger to the Duvalier dictatorship. [redacted] (Map)
