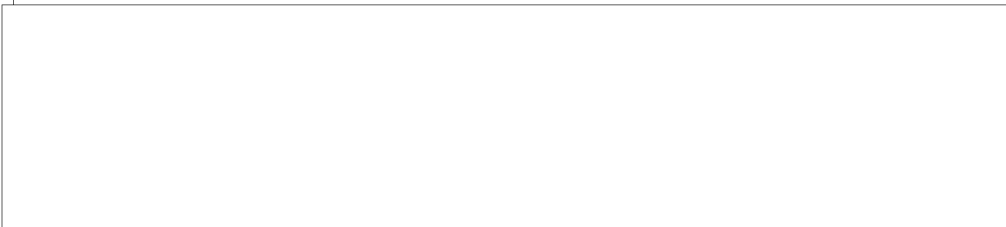
Haiti: [The Duvalier regime continues to be tormented by its inability to bring scattered rebel bands to bay.]
