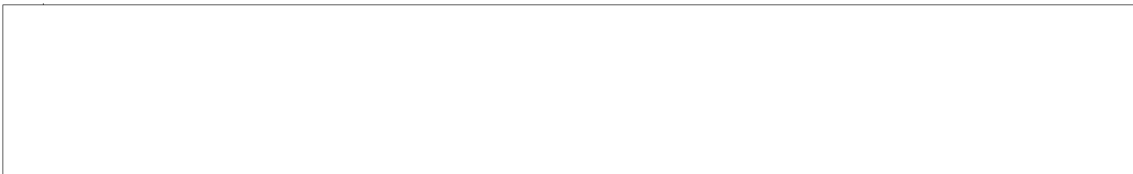

Argentina: The US Embassy reports an increasing lack of confidence in the Guido government, which, combined with the general disintegration in the political and economic situation, could result in an early move by any one of various elements advocating the overthrow of the government. There is much speculation that even those military leaders who feel responsible for maintaining Guido in power are finding it increasingly difficult to justify his continued retention in office. Dominican Republic: The ruling seven-man council is being threatened by a number of developments.
