

Dear Nancy:

In connection with the upcoming deposition of Sidney Gottlieb, my understanding is that since January of this year the CIA has been in the process of declassifying the testimony of Sidney Gottlieb before the Church Committee, subject to redactions for privileged material. It is estimated that such testimony is expected to be available in three weeks, by July 31, 1995. That information is inconsistent with that which was relayed by you to Chief Magistrate Judge Buchwald on June 26, 1995. If I obtain that testimony at about that release time, I should be able to go forward with Sidney Gottlieb's deposition on August 14, 1995.

Inasmuch as you were supposed to advise me of the availability of Mr. Gottlieb's testimony before the Church Committee, I would appreciate your confirming the latest information.
