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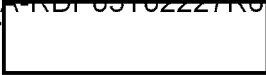

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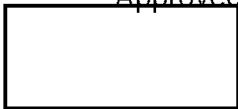



PREFACE

THIS IS THE SECOND AND FINAL OAK SUPPLEMENT REPORT ON MISSION 4033 AND PROVIDES INFORMATION ON THE COMMITTEE ON OVERHEAD RECONNAISSANCE (COMOR) TARGETS OBSERVED ON THE PHOTOGRAPHY AND NOT INCLUDED IN THE OAK REPORTS FOR THIS MISSION. ALSO INCLUDED IN THIS REPORT ARE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED NON-COMOR TARGETS REFLECTING SIGNIFICANT CHANGE, TARGETS WITH SIGNIFICANT ORDER OF BATTLE (OB) INFORMATION, AND TARGETS WHICH ARE EITHER NEWLY IDENTIFIED OR KNOWN BUT REPORTED FOR THE FIRST TIME BY NPIC.

TARGETS ARE ARRANGED IN THE OAK SUPPLEMENT BY SUBJECT AND WITHIN EACH SUBJECT BY COMOR TARGET NUMBER. PREVIOUSLY REPORTED NON-COMOR TARGETS ARE LISTED UNDER THE APPROPRIATE SUBJECT AFTER THE LISTING OF COMOR TARGETS. NEWLY REPORTED TARGETS ARE DESIGNATED AS BONUS TARGETS AND ARE LISTED AFTER THE NON-COMOR TARGETS. LOCATIONS OF TARGETS IN THIS REPORT ARE INDICATED BY THE COUNTRY CODE AND THE COORDINATES.

SELECTED PHOTOGRAPHIC REFERENCES FOR EACH TARGET FOLLOW THE DESCRIPTION OF THE TARGET. PASS NUMBERS, SUFFIXED WITH A FOR ASCENDING AND D FOR DESCENDING, ARE LISTED FIRST, FOLLOWED BY THE FRAME NUMBERS. SYMBOLS FOR LIMITING CONDITIONS AFFECTING PHOTOGRAPHY ARE C (CLEAR), SC (SCATTERED CLOUD COVER), HC (HEAVY CLOUD COVER), H (HAZE), CS (CLOUD SHADOW), S (SNOW), O (OBLIQUITY), SD (SEMIDARKNESS), D (DARKNESS), GC (GROUND COVER), CF (CAMOUFLAGE), AND GR (GROUND RESOLUTION). INTERPRETABILITY OF THE PHOTOGRAPHY IS CATEGORIZED AS G (GOOD), F (FAIR), OR P (POOR). THE EXTENT OF PHOTOGRAPHIC COVERAGE IS DENOTED BY THE SYMBOLS T (TOTAL) OR PT (PARTIAL). THE MODE OF COVERAGE IS INDICATED BY ST (STEREO), PS (PARTIAL STEREO), OR NS (NON-STEREO).

RECIPIENTS ARE CAUTIONED THAT THE INITIAL SCAN OF THE PHOTOGRAPHY IS BEING ACCOMPLISHED IN A SHORT TIME AND PRIOR TO FINAL REFINEMENT OF EPHEMERIS DATA. CONSEQUENTLY, FUTURE DETAILED ANALYSIS MAY RESULT IN MINOR ALTERATIONS. MOREOVER, RECIPIENTS ARE CAUTIONED THAT THE IDENTIFICATION OF TARGETS IS BASED PRIMARILY ON PHOTOGRAPHY AND DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A FINISHED INTELLIGENCE JUDGMENT.

1. MISSILE ACTIVITY

A SAM SUPPORT FACILITY IS NEWLY IDENTIFIED 5 NM SOUTH OF BUKHARA, USSR.

A REVETMENT WITH UNIDENTIFIED CONSTRUCTION WORK IN PROGRESS AND A LOOP ROAD SIMILAR TO THE ONE REPORTED AT KREMENCHUG SAM SITE B26-2 ARE OBSERVED AT PETROPAVLOVSK SAM SITE B28-2, USSR.

THE INSTALLATION 4 NM SOUTH OF SUMGAI, USSR, PREVIOUSLY REPORTED AS SUMGAI MILITARY INSTALLATION, IS NOW IDENTIFIED AS A MISSILE STORAGE FACILITY. EQUIPMENT OBSERVED INCLUDES, 12 SAM LAUNCHERS, 5 PROBABLE MISSILE TRANSPORTERS WITH PRIME MOVERS, AND 12 POSSIBLE OXIDIZER TRANSPORTERS WITH PRIME MOVERS.

FIFTEEN SCUD MISSILE TRANSPORT TRAILERS ARE OBSERVED IN THE [REDACTED] 4 NM ESE OF THE KIROVOGRAD/KANOTAVO AIRFIELD, USSR. THE PRESENCE OF THE SCUD MISSILES AND THE TWO EARTH-COVERED ARCH-ROOFED BUILDINGS INDICATES THE STORAGE SITE IS PROBABLY UTILIZED FOR THE STORAGE OF SURFACE-TO-SURFACE MISSILES [REDACTED]

2. AIR ACTIVITY

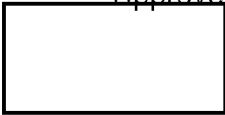
KENNEL ASM ARE IDENTIFIED ON THIS MISSION FOR THE FIRST TIME AT NIKOLAYEV/KULBAKINO AIRFIELD, USSR. TWO KENNEL ARE PARKED ON THE MAIN PARKING APRON AND 1 POSSIBLE KENNEL IS UNDERNEATH THE WING OF A POSSIBLE BADGER B. THIRTY-SIX OTHER BADGERS ARE AT THE FIELD.

A NEW 100-FT-WIDE PARKING APRON IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION 1,250 FT FROM THE NE END OF THE PARALLEL TAXIWAY AT SARY-SHAGAN AIRFIELD, USSR. CONCRETE BLOCKS HAVE BEEN LAID FOR 715 FT AND SURFACE PREPARATION EXTENDS ANOTHER 530 FT FOR A TOTAL LENGTH OF 1,345 FT. A 9,600 X 260 FT SERVICEABLE GRADED-EARTH RUNWAY PARALLELS THE NE/SW CONCRETE RUNWAY.

AN AIRFIELD WITH A 5,200 X 600 FT NW/SE SERVICEABLE GRADED-EARTH RUNWAY IS NEWLY IDENTIFIED 6 NM NW OF NEBIT-DAG, USSR.

FITTER AIRCRAFT ARE IDENTIFIED ON THIS MISSION FOR THE FIRST TIME AT KUNMADARAS AIRFIELD, HUNGARY. AIRCRAFT OBSERVED INCLUDE 27 FITTER AND 21 FAGOT/FRESCO.
