*0900-1100 any way he wants if 1100-1330 work; 1530-work*

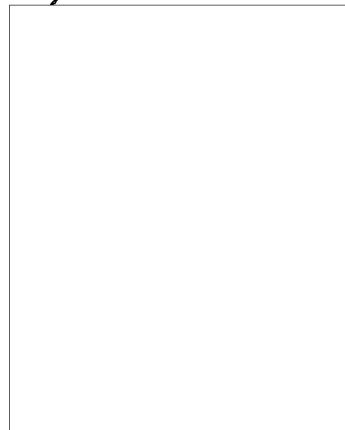
One hour each with junior and senior Naval Intell groups.
